Program LLC is to provide residential and support services in an environment focused on safety and executing effective treatment to minimize the occurrence of incidents, at the program facilities and community settings. We are here to provide a home environment for those who have challenges with intellectual disabilities. Each resident of this program will have a chance at living a productive life according to their needs. In addition the residents will gain a sense of belonging because of this unique homelike environment and staff support.

The S.C.A.L.P. program employ staff members who have Master's Degrees, expertise in behavioral analysis, autism, substance abuse treatment, relationship and family counseling, co-occurring, medical fragility, cultural competency, utilizing of PECS books, intellectual and disabilities, to demonstrate a wide range of supporting elements that best caters to our targeted population.

Our Board members were personally hand selected and each individual have over 10 years worth of

experience in their craft, that's beneficial to brainstorming effective ways of ensuring the SCALP Program is and will remain successful! S.C.A.L.P. staff members provide support 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

## Our Services

- You will share a home with one or two other individuals, and you will have your own bedroom.
- Meetings with staff to identify goals to strengthen your skills so that you can live as independently as possible.
- Make choices as to how you will spend your day, your evenings and your weekends. Individuals attend day or vocational programs and/or have jobs in the community to occupy free time in an effective manner.
- Residents work individually with staff to learn new skills. For example, if you need help in learning to take care of your personal needs such as, medication management, cooking, budgeting or shopping, we can help you with these, as well as many others.
- You will also be supported by staff in continuing your connection with your family, as family involvement is welcomed and encouraged.

- You will meet with staff to help you choose everything from your clothing to community activities in which you wish to participate. By making choices, you can continue to grow as a person.
- Your spirituality will be supported and encouraged. You will be given every opportunity to practice and participate in the religion of your choice.
- Your staff will work with you to maintain existing relationships and develop new friendships by fostering opportunities for socialization within the community.
- Our staff is certified to administer medication and can monitor those who can self-medicate.
- All of our homes are licensed by Pennsylvania's Department of Public Welfare-Office of Developmental Programs.
